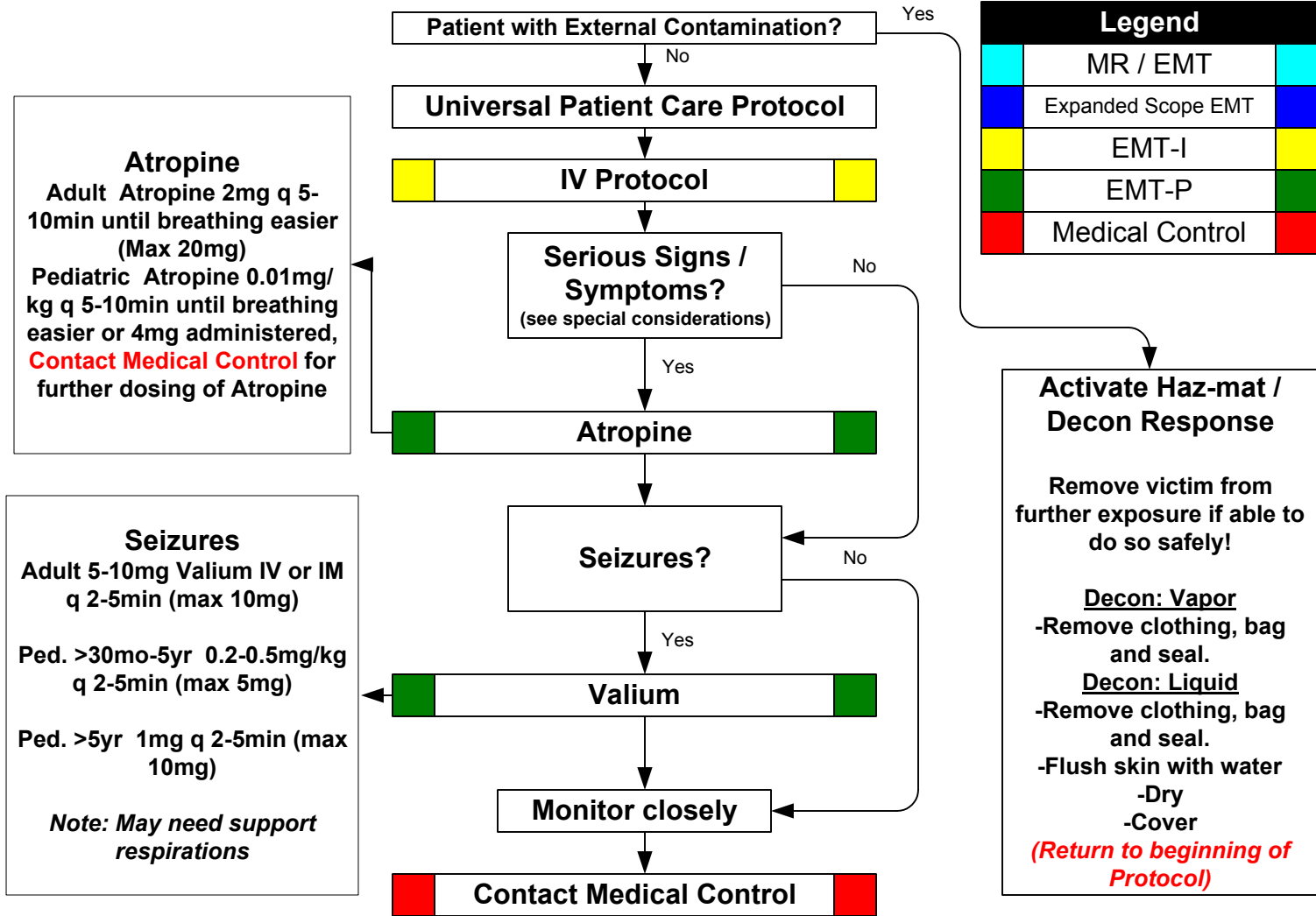


FORSYTH COUNTY EMS MEDICAL PROTOCOLS

Organophosphate / Carbamate Poisoning

History: * Recent actions, possibility of exposure to materials * Agricultural setting * Hazardous materials scene	Signs and Symptoms: * Mental status changes * Wheezing / Dyspnea * Apnea * Coma * Seizures	Special Considerations: * Do not treat pulse rate or pupils, treat respiratory distress with wheezing, secretions, apnea, and seizures. * Consider incident as a Haz-Mat scene, protect yourself and others from contamination. Contact Medical Director or his Designee. * More than 1 patient on scene, contact EMS Supervisor early.
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Pearls:
 * **Exam: Mental Status, Skin, HEENT, Heart, Lungs, Abdomen, Extremities, Neuro**
 * **Insecticides:** increased or decreased HR, increased secretions, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, pinpoint pupils
 * Signs and Symptoms:
 Salivation
 Lacrimation
 Urination
 Defecation
 Gastritis
 Emesis

* Bring container or MSDS to Hospital
